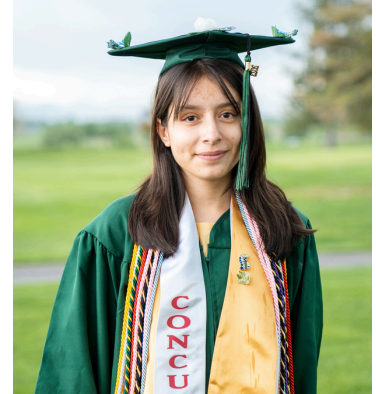


Collegian Highlight

The program prepares undergraduates with research skills through active participation in the mentor's research. She will be working on a research project aimed at youth and mental health as related to social media and will receive a stipend for the 12 week summer program.
